**A Resolution of the Governing Body of the Town of Saratoga,
Carbon County, Wyoming,**

“RESOLUTION FOR APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL PROSECUTOR”

WHEREAS, pursuant to State statutes there is a single point of entry for juvenile offenders who are cited for criminal violations of law in Carbon County, Wyoming, and

WHEREAS, as a result of this single point of entry the Carbon County Attorney’s Office tracks juvenile citations for juveniles who have been cited for both violations of local and/or State law and determines whether the juvenile should be entitled to a deferment of the charge for which they have been cited, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of justice to authorize the Carbon County Attorney’s Office from time-to-time to act as a Special Prosecuting Attorney for the Town of Saratoga when dealing with juveniles who have been cited into Saratoga Municipal Court who may be offered a deferment of the crime charged; and

WHEREAS, Ashley M. Mayfield Davis, the duly elected Carbon County Prosecuting Attorney of Carbon County, or one of her deputies has agreed to assist in juvenile matters in Saratoga Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Carbon County Attorney’s Office will provide these services free of charge to the Town of Saratoga; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Governing Body of the Town of Saratoga, Carbon County, Wyoming consents to the appointment of Ashley M. Mayfield Davis or any of her deputy county attorneys to serve as Special Deputy Prosecuting Attorney(s) in any juvenile matters that may come before the Town of Saratoga Municipal Court.
